YOU MUST BE PRESENT AT YOUR FIRE SCENE AT ALL TIMES IN CASE OF UNEXPECTED PROBLEMS.

These burning regulations must be signed annually by anyone wishing to burn during the open burning season and they are valid only during the season in which the application is signed. Furthermore the applicant must obtain a daily permit for any additional controlled burns necessary throughout the open burning season. Daily burning permits are obtained by calling the Phillips County Dispatch Office at the Phillips County Courthouse in Malta, MT., at 654-2350. A daily permit will not be issued unless the applicant has a current annual permit on file with the permitting agency.
